UPDATE of RESOLUTIONS

The Itchenor Society rules.

The Society's rules have been reviewed by the sub-committee and will be presented for discussion to the full committee at the September meeting.

Removal of elm trees in verge opposite Church Hill Farm.

The Parish Council objected to this planning application on a number of grounds. However, the application was approved by CDC and the trees have subsequently been cut down.

Old Haven.

The Society responded to a letter from Historic England by objecting to the owner's request for a certificate of immunity from listing. The Society considers Old Haven to be worthy, in view of its well documented history some of which has recently come to light, of being awarded listed building status. The Parish Council shares this view. Subsequently a further planning application was made by the owner. A strong objection to the application, including new information regarding the building of the house, was made by the Parish Council. We are pleased to report that the application was roundly rejected by both CDC and Chichester Harbour Conservancy. A Section 216 notice to improve the appearance of the house was issued by CDC at the request of the Parish Council. Whilst part of the notice had been complied with, a substantial part of the house facing The Street was left untouched. CDC deferred action against the owner pending determination of the latest planning application. As this has subsequently been rejected the Parish Council have asked CDC to ensure that the owner complies with the remaining works immediately.
